A Message from Our Executive Director



Dear Friends and Supporters,

As I reflect on the journey of the Right Solutions Foundation (RSF), I am overwhelmed with gratitude for the progress we've made and the lives we've touched. Our story began with pilot wellness boot camps, powered through our parent organization, Right Solutions Inc., where we tested innovative approaches to engage youth and build resilience. The success of these pilots demonstrated the power of intensive, culturally relevant programming in transforming lives.

Building on this foundation, RSF was launched as a dedicated nonprofit to expand our reach, deepen our programming, and establish a dedicated facility to provide wraparound services; such as mental health support, housing assistance, and ongoing mentorship; that address the holistic needs of youth and young adults.

Over the past three years, we have served 572 youth and young adults, delivering immersive, multi-day programs designed to foster lasting behavioral change. Our typical programs include 5-day boot camps, with some youth participating in multiple sessions, which reinforce skills in financial literacy, wellness, and career development. Our offerings are supported by certified professionals with credentials including CFEI® (Certified Financial Education InstructorSM), NCDFA Facilitating Career Development, and AFCPE membership, ensuring high-quality, real-world financial education aligned with trusted standards like the FDIC Money Smart Alliance Program.

Our collective efforts have led to significant outcomes:

- Over 572 youth served across all our programs in three years.
- Provided over 1,875 service hours delivered through immersive camps and sessions.
- An average attendance of 24 youth per day, with sessions reaching broader audiences.
- Youth report increased confidence, improved financial literacy, and motivation for education and career pursuits.

Looking ahead, RSF is committed to expanding our programs, securing a dedicated facility to support wraparound services, and building sustainable pathways for youth development. Our upcoming initiatives include increasing Wellness Boot Camps across LAUSD and LBUSD schools, launching digital portfolios and micro-business projects, and establishing water conservation certifications and job pipelines. We also aim to develop scholarships, host community events, and strengthen partnerships with local businesses and industry leaders to enhance mentorship, employment, and housing opportunities.

To realize this vision, we are dedicated to building organizational capacity; hiring and training additional staff and facilitators, expanding our reach into more districts, and creating infrastructure that supports long-term community impact. Our growth strategy includes seeking grants, diversifying revenue streams, and fostering collaborations that ensure sustainability and scalability.

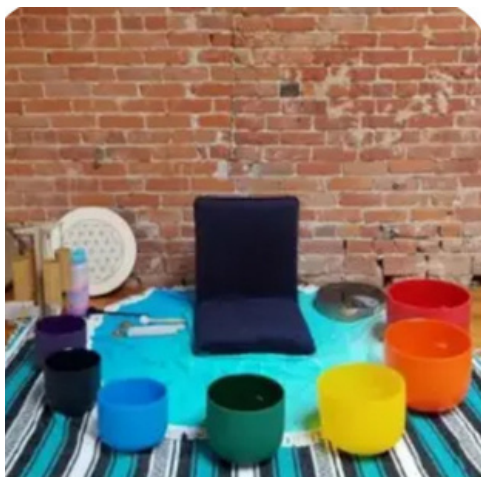

Organization Overview

Right Solutions Foundation (RSF) was established to build on the innovative youth programs piloted by our parent organization, Right Solutions Inc. Our journey began with pilot wellness boot camps designed to engage youth through culturally relevant, immersive experiences that foster resilience, confidence, and practical skills. Recognizing the impact of these efforts, RSF was formally launched as a dedicated nonprofit to expand these programs and serve more youth facing systemic barriers.



About This Report

Introduction

Introduction & The Need

Many youth in under-resourced communities face barriers related to financial literacy, emotional wellness, digital access, career exposure, and consistent support. Without intervention, these systemic barriers perpetuate cycles of disadvantage across generations.

The Right Solutions Foundation (RSF) recognizes these pressing challenges. Our trauma-informed, culturally relevant programs address the specific obstacles faced by these populations, fostering emotional resilience, life skills, and pathways to success. We serve and support youth at continuation schools, victims of sex trafficking, foster youth, and young adults impacted by the juvenile justice system.

Recent data underscores the urgency of these issues:

- According to the Kaiser Family Foundation (2021), nearly 1 in 5 young people (ages 13-24) reported experiencing a major depressive episode in the past year, a significant increase from previous years.
- The U.S. Census Bureau (2021) highlights that approximately 19 million children live in households with incomes below the federal poverty line**, indicating persistent economic hardship affecting youth development.
- The National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH) (2020) reports that over 40% of adolescents in underserved communities experience emotional distress, with higher rates of mental health issues linked to trauma and adverse childhood experiences.
- The Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (FINRA)'s 2022 National Financial Capability Study found that only 37% of adults in the lowest income quartile can answer basic financial literacy questions correctly, emphasizing the ongoing gaps in foundational financial knowledge.
- The U.S. Department of Education's Civil Rights Data Collection (2020) shows that students in under-resourced schools have significantly lower graduation rates, with disparities most notable among Black and Hispanic students, limiting their career exposure and future opportunities.

These disparities highlight the critical need for targeted, culturally relevant interventions like those provided by RSF. Our programs aim to close these gaps by equipping youth with the skills, resilience, and opportunities necessary for a successful future.

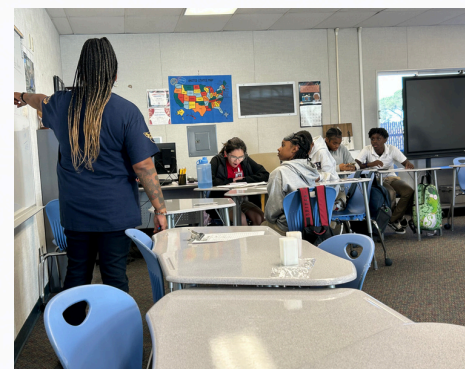

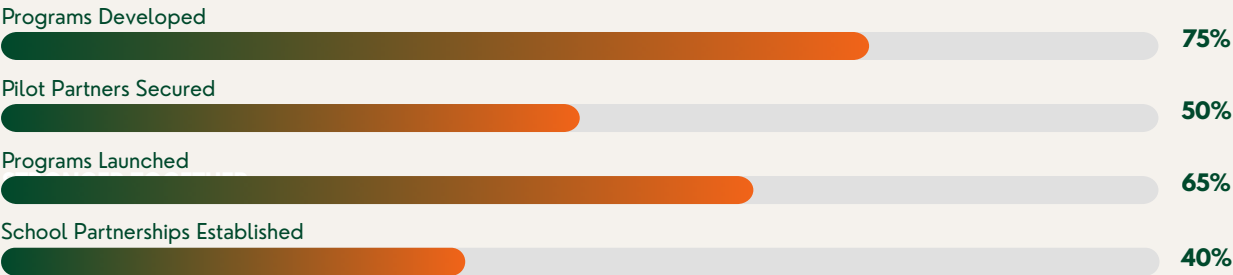

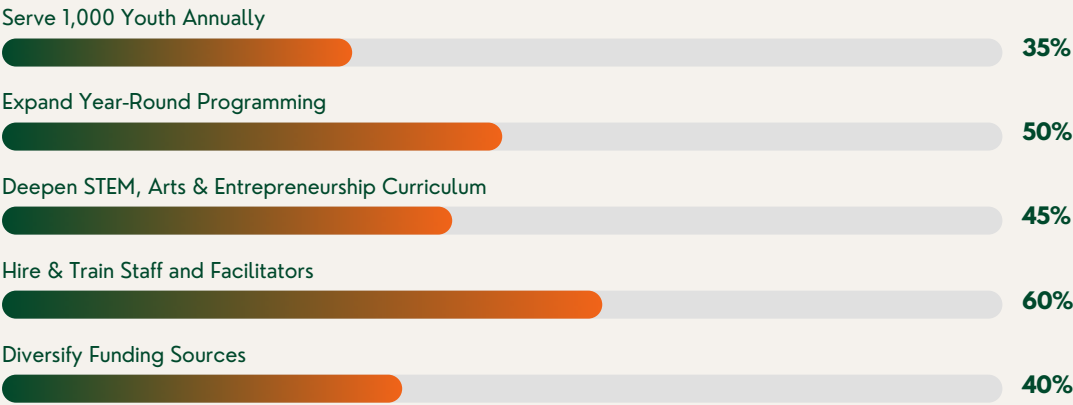

Financial Summary

Financial Information

As a newly established nonprofit organization, we do not have prior formal financial statements or audits. Our current operating budget is under development and primarily focused on expanding our program reach, securing facilities, and building sustainable operations. We are committed to establishing proper financial oversight and record-keeping once we receive funding. For this application, we have provided a preliminary budget outline that reflects our planned expenses and funding needs.

Funding & Sustainability

While initial funding of \$400,000 supported our pilot efforts over the past three years through Right Solutions Inc., ongoing funding is needed to expand our boot camps and sustain more resources for community impact. Future support through grants, fundraising, and capital investments will enable us to hire additional staff, develop new curricula, and establish dedicated facilities for Youth to Work programs, creating lasting pathways to employment and housing. We are committed to diversifying revenue streams and building long-term sustainability through strategic partnerships.

Capital Project Goal:

Funds will support the development of dedicated facilities for Youth to Work initiatives and boot camps, providing safe, accessible spaces for skill-building, mentorship, and community engagement.

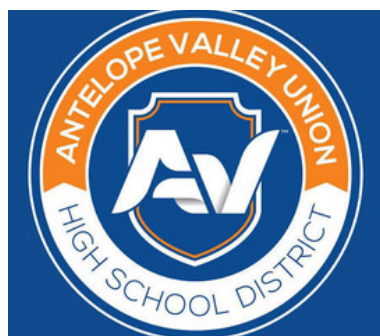
